



Representational icons created from plasma cut steel plate. Lap & plug welded to the sculpture for an embossed image. Painted with contrasting color for a visually bold statement.

Subjects for Iconography:

- ~**Fertile Farmland** via straight lines, farm tools, and/or barn (#1)
- ~**The Ice Age Floods** via flowing lines and waves
- ~**Native Americans** via arrowhead, longhouse, bow & arrow, berries/elk/deer/camas/food (#2)
- ~**Tree City** via native tree silhouettes (#6)
- ~**Historic Transportation** via steamship on river (#3)
- ~**Birdwatching** via Binoculars and native bird silhouettes (#8)
- ~**Canoeing** via oars and/or canoe graphic (#5)
- ~**Brick Factory** via rectangular symbolism
- ~**Sawmill** via axe graphic
- ~**Biking** via bike graphic (#7)
- ~**Hiking** via backpacking graphic (#4)
- ~**Tualatin River** via flowing and meandering lines (#1, #4, overall)
- ~**Fishing** via fish and/or hook graphic
- ~**Mastadon** via tusk and/or mastadon graphic
