

RESOLUTION NO. 1593-85

RESOLUTION REQUESTING STORER-METRO COMMUNICATIONS
TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT
WITH METROPOLITAN AREA COMMUNICATIONS FOR SERVICES

WHEREAS, Storer-Metro Communications, Inc. has agreed, under the terms of the franchise with the Metropolitan Area Communications Commission, to provide communications services to public agencies through its Public Communications Network, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Tualatin has made expenditures, plans, and commitments in order to use the Public Communications Network, and;

WHEREAS, Mr. Dan Murrell, Vice President and Area Manager of Storer-Metro Communications, in a letter to Mr. William J. Tierney, Administrator of the Metropolitan Area Communications Commission, dated May 7, 1985, has stated that Storer-Metro would no longer allow the addition of new users to the PCN, in apparent violation of the terms of the Storer-Metro Franchise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUALATIN, that:

Section 1. The City of Tualatin respectfully requests that the Metropolitan Area Communications Commission requires Storer-Metro to comply with the terms of their franchise concerning the Public Communications Network and to continue to perform work according to schedules previously agreed to by Storer-Metro and the Commission.
