

# Picnic Shelters




## Trestle Shelter ▲

Capacity: Up to 48 individuals  
Amenities: Picnic tables, adjacent horse-shoe pits (2) by reservation, drinking fountain.



## Patio Shelter ▲

Capacity: Up to 35 individuals  
Amenities: Barbeque, picnic tables, electricity.



## Rustic Shelter ▼

Capacity: Up to 60 individuals  
Amenities: Barbeque, picnic tables, adjacent horse-shoe pits (2) by reservation, electricity, drinking fountain.



## Main Shelter ▲

*North, South or Full Main options*  
Capacity: Up to 150 individuals  
Amenities: Barbeque, picnic tables, adjacent restrooms, electricity, water hook-up, drinking fountain.

The City of Tualatin offers five picnic shelters available for rent located at the Tualatin Community Park. Situated along the peaceful Tualatin River, the picnic shelters within the Community Park are perfect for your next family reunion, company picnic or special event.

The City of Tualatin offers several indoor and outdoor facilities to rent for your family, business, or group celebrations and meetings. Reservations are made by completing and returning the appropriate facility permit form, along with payment by cash, check or Visa/MC, after scheduling is approved. The permit is available online or at the Juanita Pohl Center at 8513 SW Tualatin Road, inside Tualatin Community Park.

Alcohol consumption is allowed only when a group alcohol permit is purchased during a City of Tualatin facility rental.\*

Information on availability of all facilities may be done by visiting or calling the Pohl Center at 503-691-3061, or emailing the office. See website for details.

Reservations are accepted from 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday - Friday.

The indoor facilities are available year-round, with scheduling options from three (3) months in advance for general events; and six (6) months for wedding receptions, anniversary celebrations, and reunions.

All sports fields are available for rental at the Juanita Pohl Center. Shelters are only available for reservation at the Tualatin Community Park, Ibach and Jurgens park shelters are first-come, first-serve.

## Juanita Pohl Center

The Juanita Pohl Center is located in beautiful Tualatin Community Park at 8513 SW Tualatin Road. The center can be reserved on an hourly basis (2 hr min.) for your next party, meeting or special event. Weekday evenings 3.30-11pm, and weekends 8am-11pm are available for rentals. *Please include 1 hr clean time and all set-up time.*



Capacity: up to 160 individuals  
Amenities: Tables and chairs, restrooms, ample parking, full service kitchen by reservation, building monitors available.



Multi-Purpose Room  
Capacity: up to 20 individuals  
Amenities: Tables and chairs, restrooms, building monitors available

## Heritage Center


The Tualatin Heritage Center is located at 8700 SW Sweek Road and contains the Heritage Museum and is staffed by the Tualatin Historical Society. It is located near the Sweek Pond Natural Area and is the perfect space for lectures, meetings and medium-sized parties. *Please include 1 hour clean time and all set-up.*



Capacity: up to 75 individuals  
Amenities: Chairs and limited number of tables, restrooms, patio space, parking/ overflow parking behind Police Department.

## Brown's Ferry Community Center

Located along the Tualatin River in picturesque **Brown's Ferry Park, the Brown's Ferry Community Center** is the perfect retreat within the city. The center is a great location for retreats, meetings & parties.



Capacity: Up to 40 individuals; room capacity for a single meeting is 20 persons.  
Amenities: Stove, fridge, folding chairs, tables, restrooms and building monitor.  
Note: Parking is very limited next to the center, but ample parking is available from the park parking lot, .4 of a mile from building.

## Library Community Room

The Tualatin Library Community Room is located at 18878 SW Martinazzi Avenue and is available for public use\*. The room can be rented on an hourly basis for large public gatherings during library hours only. The room contains a white board and tables and chairs.

\*See rules, regulations and classifications regarding rental and usage of the Tualatin Library Community Room. *All meetings and programs must be open to the general public. Soliciting for, or conducting business is not allowed.*



Capacity: Up to 147 individuals  
Amenities: Tables & chairs, restrooms and white board.

The Library has 2 smaller conference rooms for non-commercial use during Library hours, 2 hr max. Call 503.691.3071 for these reservations.
