




# WE ASKED, YOU ANSWERED!

In 2016, the City of Tualatin conducted a resident survey to gauge the community's opinion on City service delivery, and what people think about Tualatin's livability across several key areas. The City used the National Citizen Survey (NCS), a nationally recognized citizen survey tool, to conduct this statistically valid survey, which was provided to resident in paper and online in both English and in Spanish. We learned that Tualatin enjoys a very high quality of life, our residents love our parks and our community enjoys a robust economy. This report highlights each of the key areas that were measured in the survey, and identifies those areas where we have done well as well as those areas that we know we have work to do.

## **KEY AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT: TRAFFIC**

We heard in the survey, and we hear very often from residents that traffic in Tualatin remains challenging. Traffic signal timing, traffic flow on major streets, and ease of travel by car continue to be key areas for improvement to boost the quality of life for those who live, work and play in Tualatin.

In terms of transit, only 27% of residents had reported using it and only 68% rated the services as excellent as good. However, both of these areas were rated higher than in previous surveys.
