Intent:

Request TPARK's support in asking the City Council to design and pass ordinance language making all City Park and City maintained properties smoke and tobacco free.

Why:

- To support the City's goal of having a Healthy Tualatin.
- To provide an environment that promotes protective factors for youth and families to recreate in smoke and tobacco free parks and on City property.
- Save the City resources on park/city property clean up.

When:

As soon as practical

What's Happening Outside Tualatin:

- Forest Grove Tobacco-free policy at City Property and all events
- Sherwood 100% tobacco-free policy for all City Property and looking at including smoking and language for e-cigarettes
- Beaverton 100% tobacco-free and definition includes smoking and e-cigarettes
- Washington County Commissioners voted to adopt a smoke free campus
- THPRD 100% smoke-free

Summary:

Tualatin Together collaborates with partners to enhance and support a community environment that discourages and reduces youth substance abuse and promotes factors that protect our youth and families. Council's 2020 goals "#2: Protect and expand natural spaces," and Goal #6: "A Livable, family-oriented, safe, healthy and active-living. " are the simple reasons we believe our parks should be smoke & tobacco free. Tualatin Together's partners such as the Tualatin Library, Meridian Park Hospital, TVF&R, our faith community, law enforcement and our youth all help us plan for effective prevention work. We believe that a huge step forward in discouraging Tualatin Youth from making decisions to start using or abusing a substance is by limiting the places they can use it and where youth see adults using it in public settings.
