A. CALL TO ORDER

Committee Chair Buck Braden called the meeting to order at 6:33pm.

Parks and Recreation Director Ross Hoover updated the committee on the Stoneridge Park redesign process. This process has included extensive outreach to the neighboring community in Spanish. Approximately 60% of all returned surveys were completed in Spanish.

1. Recreation Program Update

Recreation Manager Julie Ludemann updated the committee on summer recreation programs, including summer camps, virtual programming for adults, ¡Viva Tualatin! craft bag distribution, and a new website and newsletter highlighting virtual programs and activities.

2. TAAC Annual Report

Julie Ludemann presented the 2019-2020 TAAC Annual Report to the committee. This report will be given to Tualatin City Council on Monday, September 14th by Committee Chair Buck Braden. Committee members provided input and updates to the report, specifically to the 2020-2021 goals section. The goals were updated to read: expand storm drain art program, complete traffic wrap at SW Martinazzi Ave, install street art mural, identify future arts programs and projects, and continue to support local arts programming through grants and awards.
