A. CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Brett Hamilton called the meeting to order at 6:34pm

B. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

D. NEW BUSINESS

1. **Community Park Mural** – Artist Redstone Rodolfo Serna joined the meeting to present a draft of the art design for the west wall of the picnic shelter at Community Park. Redstone began his presentation with a land acknowledgement and song. The committee provided feedback on the design.

E. OLD BUSINESS

1. **Traffic Signal Box Wrap** – The committee reviewed the mock up designs for two traffic signal box wraps and provided comment. Julie will finalize designs with company and schedule an install date.
2. **Arts Agency Contribution Program** – The committee reviewed the website content and application for the 2022 TACC Arts Agency grant program. Julie will re-word sections on the application to clarify that it is open to both individuals and organizations, then promote on the City's social media and other platforms. Applications will be reviewed at the June TAAC meeting.
3. **Veterans Plaza Update** – Ross Hoover updated the committee on the community outreach process and design options. Committee members were encouraged to review the design options and take the survey on the City's website. The committee discussed the Veterans Plaza and emphasized the importance of focusing on all aspects of military service, not just war and combat.
4. **Parks Funding Update** – Ross Hoover updated the committee on the process of determining how to pay for the next generation of parks investments. The City is working with a consulting firm on community surveys and focus groups, and results will be presented at the City Council meeting on April 25th.

F. COMMUNICATIONS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS

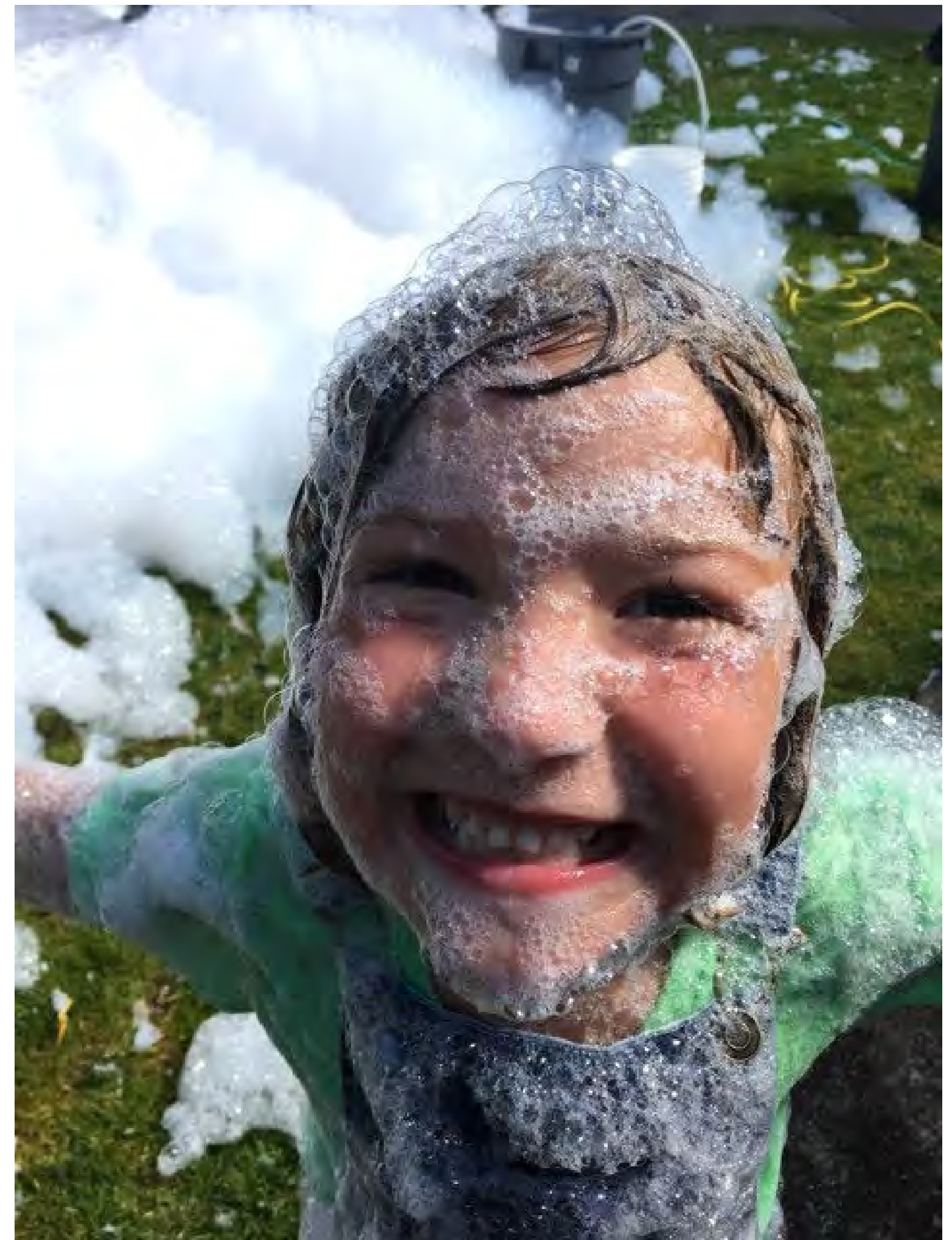

- Over 1000 visits to the Makerspace in its first 6 months

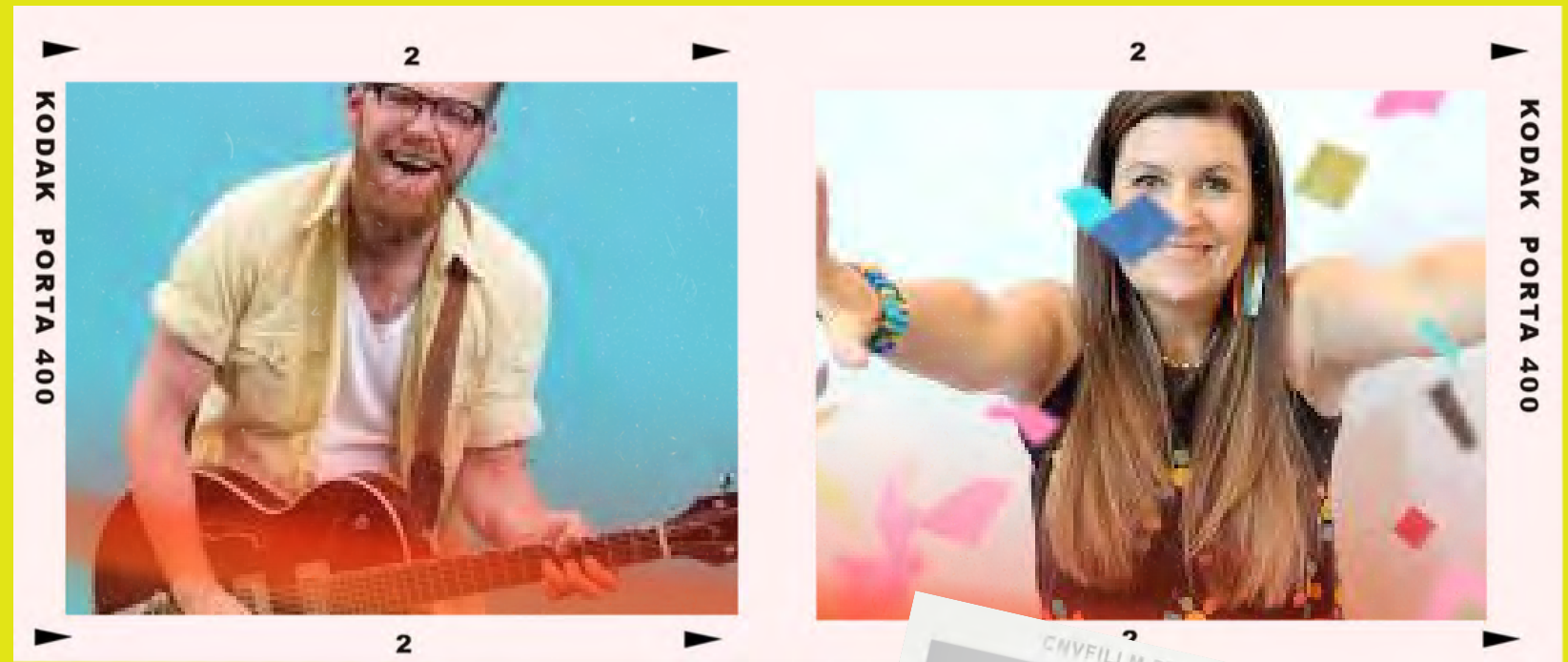
