## Tualatin Arts Advisory Committee Regular Meeting Minutes January 17, 2023

### **A. CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Janet Steiger Carr called the meeting to order at 6:33pm

### **B. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Minutes of the December 20, 2022 combined TAAC/TPARK meeting were approved with corrections on a motion from Kathleen Silloway and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mason Hall.

### **C. COMMUNICATIONS**

1. Chair – Janet Steiger Carr congratulated Counselor Bridget Brooks on her re-election and re-appointment as TAAC Council Liaison.
2. Council Liaison – Counselor Bridget Brooks updated the committee on Council activities and other information including the City Council advance, new routes in Tualatin provided by Ride Connection, and the renewal of the Republic Services contract. Additionally, Counselor Brooks described other committees on which she serves, including the Regional Water Providers Consortium, and the Washington County Policy Advisory Board.
3. Staff – Julie Ludemann, Recreation Manager, updated the committee on upcoming park projects, including greenway trail and Veteran's Plaza updates.
4. Public – none

### **D. OLD BUSINESS**

1. **Traffic Signal Box Wraps** – Julie Ludemann, staff, reported that all art has been received and is in the wrap design phase, with design mockups anticipated soon.

### **E. NEW BUSINESS**

1. **Outside Agency Grants** – Julie Ludemann reviewed the existing application for outside agency grants. Jeannine Hart asked how this grant is promoted, to which Julie responded that the grant is shared on the City's website, social media outlets, and is shared with regional arts organizations including Tualatin Valley Creates and Regional Arts and Culture Consortium.
2. **Tualatin Heritage Center Art Show**– Chair Janet Steiger Carr reported on a possible art show featuring the City's collection to be curated by and held at the Tualatin Heritage Center in August 2023. Janet indicated that 21 pieces of the City's collection have been selected as candidates for the show. The

committee discussed the potential for future ways to share the City's collection with the public, and ideas for promoting the THC show. Kathleen Silloway made a motion to allow the temporary loan of City art to the Tualatin Heritage Center for the purposes of an art show. Motion was seconded by Mason Hall and approved unanimously. Counselor Brooks recommended including an explanation of TAAC as part of the exhibit to demonstrate how City government works for the public good.

#### **F. COMMUNICATIONS FROM COMMITTEE MEMBERS**

Kathleen Silloway announced that Mask & Mirror will present *Proof* at the Tualatin Heritage Center, opening this weekend. Counselor Brooks invited everyone to the *Art to Feed the Soul* reception March 4<sup>th</sup> at 11:30am at the Juanita Pohl Center. Janet Steiger Car announced the Portland Center Stage production of *Ms. Holmes & Ms. Watson*.
