2010 Survey:

- ▶ Multi-contact mailed survey
- ▶ Representative sample of 1,200 residents and households
 - ▲ 330 surveys returned: 30% response rate
- ▶ 5% margin of error
- ▶ Data statistically weighted to reflect population
