SUBJECT:	CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SW 124 th AVENUE / SW MYSLONY STREET TO SW TUALATIN-SHERWOOD ROAD	

ISSUE BEFORE THE COMMISSION:

Whether the Tualatin Development Commission should approve Change Order No. 1 for construction of the SW 124th Avenue / SW Myslony Street to SW Tualatin-Sherwood Road (see attached map).

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Commission approve the attached change order and that the Chairman and Administrator be authorized to execute said Change Order No. 1.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- This action is not a public hearing.
- This change order covers the cost of additional work resulting from:
 - Relocating existing chain link fence along the Tualatin Island Green's property to function as temporary construction fencing.
 - Washington County requirements to modify the signal controller and signal poles.
 - Storm sewer pipe quantity increase and modification to the installation depth.
 - o Installation of a Clean Water Services required water quality manhole.
 - Construction if a rip rap outfall pad due to the water quality manhole.
 - Adjustment to the installation of the sanitary sewer line due to an existing culvert and provision to allow an abutting property to connect to the sanitary sewer line.

- Modifying a sanitary sewer manhole to accommodate the modified pipe installation depth.
- To proceed with the project the Commission needs to approve Change Order No.
 1.
- The expectation for project completion is February 2009.
- The Commission awarded the bid for SW 124th Avenue on May 27, 2008 in the amount of \$2,582,987.80.
- There are no criteria to apply to this request.

OUTCOMES OF DECISION:

Approval of Change Order No. 1 for SW 124th Avenue will result in the following:

- 1. Enables the contractor to move forward on the construction of SW 124th Avenue.
- 2. Protects an abutting property owner from possible property damage.
- 3. Allows 124th Avenue to be constructed in a manner that satisfies Washington County and Clean Water Services design standards.
- 4. Provides a storm sewer system that meets the needs of the roadway project.
- 5. Provides a sanitary sewer that meets the needs to service abutting properties.

Not approving Changer Order No. 1 for SW 124th Avenue will result in the following:

- 1. Delay payment to contractor.
- 2. Delay construction of SW 124th Avenue.
- 3. Provide opportunity for negotiation of unit pricing and lump sum amounts.

ALTERNATIVES TO RECOMMENDATION:

Alternatives evaluated to approval of Change Order No. 1 are as follows:

- 1. Reject the change orders proposed by the contractor.
- 2. Negotiate costs of change order items.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost for Change Order No. 1 is \$38,955.25. The current project cost is \$2,621,943.05, which is 101% of the original contract amount. This is within budget for this project.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:

Public involvement is not required as part of this action.

CHANGE ORDER NO. 1

TO THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SW 124th AVENUE /SW MYSLONY STREET TO SW TUALATIN-SHERWOOD ROAD

This Change Order No. 1 modifies the agreement by and between Northwest Earthmovers Inc., hereinafter referred to as the Contractor, and the Tualatin Development Commission, hereinafter referred to as the Owner, for the Construction of SW 124th Avenue /SW Myslony Street to SW Tualatin-Sherwood Road, to the extent described below:

1. For relocating existing chain link fence at west side of job to provide temporary fencing for Tualatin Island Greens the Owner will pay the Contractor the following lump sum amount:

2. For modifying signal controller and signal pole per revised sheets TS-1 to TS-5 and revised specifications Section 2920.42 it is agreed that the Owner will pay the Contractor the following lump sum amount:

3. For increasing the storm sewer pipe quantity from 2670 lineal feet to 2678 lineal feet and lowering the depth of the pipe to accommodate a Clean Water Services required 60-inch Water Quality Manhole it is agreed that the Owner will pay the Contractor the following:

4. For installation of the required Concrete Manhole, 60-inch Water Quality it is agreed that the Owner will pay the Contractor the following lump sum amount:

5. For one Rip Rap outfall pad associated with the 60-inch Water Quality Manhole and additional pipe length it is agreed that the Owner will pay the Contractor the following lump sum amount:

6. For modifications to the sanitary sewer pipe to address: 1) A flattened pipe slope, 2) A deepened pipe that allows Tualatin Island Greens connection to the sanitary line and to construct the line under a 36-inch culvert that conveys storm water from Columbia Corrugated Box, 3) reducing the pipe length by 26 feet from 1,750 to 1,724 to accommodate a relocated placement of a manhole the Owner will pay the Contractor the following:
