CALL TO ORDER

Council President Davis called the meeting to order at 6 15 p.m.

1. *Quarterly Regional Land Use and Transportation Update*

Community Development Director Aquilla Hurd-Ravich and Management Analyst Garet Prior presented a quarterly regional land use and transportation update. Analyst Prior stated quarterly report updates will be used to help Council further understand Oregon land use and transportation systems, provide strategic policy feedback, and coordinate efforts between the Council, staff, and community members. Analyst Prior presented Council with a Transportation Policy and Funding Map. He stated the map displays the connection between decision-making officials and funding sources.

Councilor Kellogg stated he would like to see cyclical programs included on the map so Council can track when those funds are available. In addition, he would like to have a map that includes current city projects. City Manager Lombos stated the Tualatin Moving Forward website has a map that shows bond funded and other transportation projects around the City.

Councilor Brooks asked how Council knows when there are events that are appropriate for lobbying for funding. Analyst Prior stated staff sends communication about meetings to Council with highlights and agenda topics where they may be opportunities available.

Councilor Reyes asked how projects are selected for funding. Director Hurd-Ravich stated projects are identified through the master planning process.

Councilor Kellogg asked when the Transportation System Plan will be evaluated. Director Hurd-Ravich stated a refresh is slated to begin in 2020.

Council President Davis stated she would like to see decision making framework for all the organizations included on the map.

2. Council Meeting Agenda Review, Communications & Roundtable.

Councilor Kellogg stated he attended the SW Corridor Steering Committee where they heard testimony in opposition on the proposed line along 74th Avenue. The next meeting for the committee will be on March 28 where they will discuss the Bonita to Bridgeport options. Decisions from the committee are expected to come in April or May.


Councilor Reyes attended the Coffee with the Mayor group.


