



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – March 7, 2024

<p><b>Boones Ferry Rd from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Sagert St and from Ibach St to Iowa Dr</b></p>	<p>Construction started this week on a new traffic signal pole (and new wires under the road) on the southwest corner of Boones Ferry Rd and Avery St to accommodate a short right turn lane for eastbound traffic on Avery St turning right to head south on Boones Ferry Rd. Delays are likely during construction.</p> <p>A contractor has replaced a damaged sewer line and lowered an existing water meter near the intersection of Boones Ferry Rd at Warm Springs St. The contractor will be pouring the new sidewalk and curb ramps next week. Delays likely during construction.</p>
<p><b>Tualatin- Sherwood Rd (from Teton Ave to Sherwood)</b></p>	<p>Washington County's contractor is adding travel lanes and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. They are also building a new 66" water line to carry Willamette River water to Beaverton, Aloha, and Hillsboro. They are now working on excavation along the north side of Tualatin-Sherwood Road for the widened roadway and pathway. <p><b>Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5</b></p>	<p>The contractor has activated the minor modifications to the Nyberg / I-5 South traffic signal to facilitate bike safety. Final striping and pavement markings (to help drivers more easily see what lane to be in) will be installed at night when the weather is dry enough and warm enough for the striping/markings to stick properly. Delays possible.</p>
<p><b>67<sup>th</sup>, 68<sup>th</sup> Avenues and Sagert Street</b></p>	<p>The contractor has removed and replaced (at their expense) a section of sidewalk along Sagert St near 68<sup>th</sup> that did not meet standards.</p> <p>City crews are planning to install additional 'No Parking' signage to clarify existing no-parking areas on the inside of the 67<sup>th</sup> / 68<sup>th</sup> Avenues loop in the next week.</p> <p>The contractor is planning to install the rest of the new raised curb to provide a separate walkway/ bikeway on the Sagert Street bridge over I-5 next week (weather permitting – it needs to be dry enough and warm enough for the epoxy to stick properly. Vehicle travel lanes have been narrowed for pedestrian space and safety.</p>

<b>Herman Rd (Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave)</b>	The contractor is working along the north side of the road building stormwater treatment planters and irrigation, and doing final cleanup. Delays possible.
<b>Plambeck Gardens - Boones Ferry Rd south of Norwood Rd</b>	A developer is constructing the Plambeck Gardens affordable housing complex on the East side of Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road and south of Horizon Church.
<b>108<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Tualatin Rd to Leveton Dr)</b>	A contractor for Lam Research is building frontage improvements along 108 <sup>th</sup> Avenue in conjunction with development on the Lam Research site.
