

## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – August 30, 2023

Herman Rd (Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave)	Herman Road (from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave) is closed from August 17 <sup>th</sup> through September 11th for roadway reconstruction. The 'hard' closure is between Tualatin Road and the industrial access private rail crossing (shown on some maps as Powder Ct). Residences on the north side are typically accessed from the East; Businesses are accessed from the West.  During this closure, the contractor has constructed a new storm drainage system under the roadway and is building/rebuilding the roadway base and pavement structure. They will then construct new curbs along the road and new sidewalk and stormwater planters along the North side of the road. The detour route is Tualatin Road and Teton Ave. Expect additional traffic on the detour route, and some delays. Work is planned through October.
Boones Ferry Rd from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Sagert St and from Ibach St to Iowa Dr	The contractor will be paving the full width of Boones Ferry Road near the Ibach Street intersection September 7 <sup>th</sup> through 9 <sup>th</sup> . Traffic will be controlled by flaggers; expect significant delays during paving.  Paving originally scheduled this week was delayed due to a contractor equipment issue.  The contractor is removing and replacing curb ramps at the intersections of Boones Ferry Road with Ibach St, Iowa Dr, Avery St, and Mohawk St. Some lanes will be narrowed, and traffic delays are possible. The contractor will start removing and replacing curb ramps at the Boones Ferry Road intersections with and Warm Springs Street next week.  Utility crews are working along Boones Ferry Road between Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and
Boones Ferry / Norwood Waterline between Ibach St and B-Level Reservoirs	Sagert St in preparation for roadway construction in a couple of weeks. More information is at www.boonesferrycorridor.com.  The contractor has completed and tested the new section of 18" water main along Boones Ferry Road from Ibach St to Norwood Rd and along Norwood Road from Boones Ferry Rd to the reservoir connection at 89th Ave. They are currently making final connections of the new water line to the existing system. Next week they will be restoring landscaping etc. and cleaning up. Delays are possible.

Boones Ferry Road Waterline from Norwood Rd to Greenhill Ln	A contractor has constructed a new waterline along the east side of Boones Ferry Road from Norwood Rd South to the new Plambeck Gardens housing development under construction between Horizon Church and Greenhill Lane. The contractor has paved over the new water pipes on Boones Ferry Road.
Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5; Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Martinazzi Ave	The contractor has revised the Tualatin-Sherwood Road median from Martinazzi to the Cabelas/Fred Meyer signal as part of a project to improve Tualatin-Sherwood Road/Nyberg St traffic flow to the I-5 interchange through more efficient lane usage. Work continues removing and replacing curb ramps at the Nyberg St / Cabela's/Fred Meyer intersection. Most construction is being done at night to minimize traffic disruption but, as traffic is so busy in this area, some additional delay is likely. Paving and traffic control changes are scheduled in late September.  The contractor has striped improved bike lanes along Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Martinazzi Ave (by the Library), and a new section of bike lane on Tualatin Road north of Boones Ferry Road.
Hwy 99W (124 <sup>th</sup> Ave to Pacific Dr / Pony Ridge Neighborhood)	A contractor is building a new pedestrian walkway along the northwest side of Hwy 99W from 124 <sup>th</sup> Ave to Pacific Drive and the Pony Ridge Neighborhood. This involves daytime right lane closures on Hwy 99W southbound while crews are working. Some trees and shrubs have been removed as their roots were in the area needed for the walkway and as the trees were already compromised due to proximity to utility lines. Crews will be working next week excavating and preparing the base for the new pathway.
Nyberg Creek Area West of 65 <sup>th</sup> Avenue	A contractor is constructing a replacement for a deteriorated sewer line along the south side of Nyberg Creek west of 65 <sup>th</sup> Ave near the Rolling Hills Apartments, and has repaired some manholes north of the apartments. Work continues this week to install new sewer pipe south of Nyberg Creek.
Plambeck Gardens - Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road	The developer is constructing the Plambeck Gardens affordable housing complex on the East side of Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road and south of Horizon Church.
67 <sup>th</sup> , 68 <sup>th</sup> Avenues and Sagert Street	On August 28 <sup>th</sup> Council authorized a contract to construct new street lights and sidewalk, curb ramp, and crosswalk improvements along 67 <sup>th</sup> and 68 <sup>th</sup> Avenues north of Sagert St in the Las Casitas neighborhood, and a new crosswalk with flashing lights across Sagert

	Street west of 68 <sup>th</sup> Avenue. With this, all of the Tualatin Moving Forward projects are now either under construction or complete.
Nyberg St between I-5 and 65 <sup>th</sup> Avenue	A contractor for Washington County has poured new curb ramps to meet ADA standards along Nyberg Street east of Interstate 5. <b>The County plans to pave Nyberg Street from Interstate 5 to 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue September 5<sup>th</sup> and 6th. They plan to pave at night to reduce traffic disruption. Expect delays during night paving and possible daytime delays due to changed roads.</b>
Avery Street between Boones Ferry Rd and Martinazzi Ave	The City's paving program has repaved Avery Street from Boones Ferry Road to Martinazzi Avenue. Striping is scheduled to be installed Friday – with most of the centerline omitted and white shoulder lines installed denoting parking lanes to make this part of Avery Street look more like a neighborhood street and visually narrow the traveled way to reduce vehicle speeds.
Tualatin- Sherwood Rd (from Teton Ave to Sherwood)	Washington County's contractor is building an additional travel lane and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. Traffic lanes have shifted through the work zone as the contractor is now working more on the north side of the road, including tree removal and construction of new curb and sidewalk.
