

## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – May 10, 2023

Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5	Construction is planned to start next week (and last through October) to improve Tualatin-Sherwood Road and Nyberg St from downtown Tualatin to the I-5 interchange to make traffic flow more efficient through improved lane usage. Most of the construction will be done at night to minimize disruption of traffic. However, as traffic is so busy in this area, some additional delay is likely.
Herman Rd	Construction starts next week (May 15 <sup>th</sup> ) on a city-funded project to widen and reconstruct Herman Rd from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave. Some trees will be removed next week along the north side of Herman Road in front of the Q Pacific property.  Major road construction (including a three-week Herman Road closure) is planned in July and August, with the project lasting until October.
Martinazzi Ave at Mohawk St and at Fred Meyer, Boones Ferry at 84 <sup>th</sup>	The contractor is making final adjustments to the new flashing lights at the crosswalks across Boones Ferry near 84 <sup>th</sup> and across Martinazzi at Mohawk. The contractor will be installing new crosswalk stripes Friday evening 5/12 into Saturday morning 5/13. Traffic delays possible.
Hazelbrook Area	The contractor is activating the new flashing lights at the Tualatin Rd crosswalks this week. A brighter streetlight has been installed at the Hazelbrook/Jurgens intersection. This project has also striped new bike lanes along the existing travel lanes along Jurgens Ave and a portion of Tualatin Rd, and is planning to restripe two crosswalks across Tualatin Rd tomorrow (Thursday, May 11th).
Boones Ferry Rd from Avery St to Norwood Rd	The new pathways have been poured and the newly-added bike lanes paved along Boones Ferry Rd from Sagert St to Ibach St. PGE is working to energize the new lights along the pathway on the west side of Boones Ferry between Avery and Siletz. More information is at boonesferrycorridor.com.  Paving and striping is planned Mid-June, including two days of significant traffic delays during paving operations.  Phase 2 of this project – From Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Nasoma St, and the Avery St and Iowa St intersections is coming this Summer.

	Utility companies (PGE and Ziply) are relocating poles and wires to make way for Phase 2 of this project and project to build a new water line from Ibach St to south of Norwood Road this summer. Delays likely when they are working.
Tualatin- Sherwood Rd and Teton Ave	Washington County's contractor is building an additional travel lane and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. Contractors for utility companies are making way for the Road construction. The contractor plans to shut down the Tualatin-Sherwood Road signals at 124 <sup>th</sup> and Cipole Tuesday and Wednesday nights next week (May 16-18), and plans to close Tualatin-Sherwood Road at the railroad crossing between Oregon St and Gerda Ln from Friday evening June 2 through Monday Morning June 5 to replace and widen the railroad crossing. Expect significant delays and traffic effects around the area. Norwood Rd	A private developer is widening Norwood Rd in conjunction with the large residential Autumn Sunrise Subdivision south of Norwood Rd west of Interstate 5. <b>The developer has paved Norwood Road, and will be paving the streets inside the subdivision this week.</b>
Nyberg Lane East of 65 <sup>th</sup> Ave	A private developer is building the Tualatin River Trail connection behind the new apartment complex on the old RV Park property along Nyberg Lane near its intersection with Nyberg St and 65th Ave. The contractor has paved portions of Nyberg Lane in front of their development.
Nyberg St between I-5 and 65 <sup>th</sup> Avenue	A contractor for Washington County is retrofitting curb ramps to meet ADA standards along Nyberg Street east of Interstate 5. This is the first part of a project to pave Nyberg Street from Interstate 5 to 65 <sup>th</sup> Avenue this summer.
65th Avenue south of Nyberg St	A contractor will be drilling in the parking lot of the medical office on the west side of 65 <sup>th</sup> Avenue south of Nyberg Creek to install groundwater level monitoring in advance of a sewer project along the south side of Nyberg Creek.

65 <sup>th</sup> Ave near Meridian Hospital	The contractor has poured new sidewalk, ramps, and a center island to add a crosswalk with flashing lights across 65th Ave near Meridian Park Hospital. They have striped the crosswalk and plan to activate the flashing lights next week.
Tualatin Road Railroad Crossing (Near Community Park)	A contractor will be working Saturday, May 13 on the sidewalk along Tualatin Road at the railroad crossing near Community Park to address some ADA rail crossing issues
