

## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – FEBRUARY 3, 2023

Tualatin- Sherwood Rd and Teton Ave	Washington County's contractor is excavating to widen and add pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Road from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. They have cleared the area for roadway widening from 124 <sup>th</sup> Ave towards 115 <sup>th</sup> Ave. Contractors for utility companies (PGE, NW Natural, Comcast, etc.) are also relocating their lines to make way for the road construction. Traffic delays are likely. Boones Ferry Rd from Blake/Alsea to Arikara Dr	The contractor is replacing the pathway along <b>Boones Ferry Road from Arikara Dr to Ibach St.</b> Next week they will move to the East side of Boones Ferry and work their way north from Ibach Street. They will continue working along the newly-poured and reopened pathway on the west side of Boones Ferry between Sagert and Ibach; while the path has reopened, please use caution in this active construction zone. More information is at www.boonesferrycorridor.com. While the contractor is doing their best to get school traffic through, Expect delays between Arikara and Ibach during the day.
Norwood Rd	A private developer is installing storm drainage and water pipes under <b>Norwood Road</b> to serve the first phase of the large residential <b>Autumn Sunrise Subdivision</b> south of Norwood Road west of Interstate 5. Current work includes laying pipes for sanitary sewer, storm drainage, and drinking water. <b>Vermillion St and 89<sup>th</sup> Ave</b> will be closed periodically north of Norwood Rd and traffic on Norwood is being flagged through one lane during construction; Delays are likely for the next few weeks.
Martinazzi Ave at Mohawk St	A contractor has poured new curb ramps and a new bus stop on Martinazzi Ave near Fred Meyer and will be installing crosswalk lights in a few weeks at the intersections of Martinazzi Ave at Mohawk St and Boones Ferry Road at 84 <sup>th</sup> Ave. Paving is planned next week. These are part of the Neighborhood Traffic Safety portion of the Tualatin Moving Forward Program.
Blake St and Makah Ct	The contractor has completed the pipe work for the <b>upsized sewer main under</b> Blake St and Makah Ct east of Martinazzi Ave. The trench areas on Blake Street

	(east of Martinazzi) and Makah Ct have been paved; the contractor is now working on final completion and cleanup.
Hazelbrook Area	The contractor has poured some new curb ramps along Jurgens Ave as part of a project in the Hazelbrook Area (near Tualatin Road, Jurgens Avenue, and Hazelbrook Road and School) to install flashing lights at crosswalks on Tualatin Road (at Jurgens, Teton, and 108th), Restripe Hazelbrook Road and Jurgens Avenue to add bike lanes, make pedestrian improvements at the Hazelbrook/Jurgens intersection, and add a crosswalk and curb extension across Jurgens Avenue at Kiowa Street.
Herman Rd	The private developer building new industrial buildings along <b>Herman Road</b> (between Tualatin Road and Teton Ave) will be working in Herman Road to install new water connections for the new buildings. Two-way traffic will be in a single lane controlled by flaggers; Delays are likely on Herman between Teton and Tualatin Rd for the next few weeks.  The City is now seeking construction bids to reconstruct, widen, and add bike lanes and sidewalk along <b>Herman Road from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave</b> . Bids are due
	February 14 <sup>th</sup> , with construction planned from March through October.
65 <sup>th</sup> Ave near Meridian Hospital	Construction is planned to start February 6 to add a crosswalk with flashing lights across 65th Ave near Meridian Park Hospital.
Nyberg St and 65 <sup>th</sup> Ave	A private developer is building the Tualatin River Trail connection behind the new apartment complex on the old RV Park property along Nyberg Lane near its intersection with Nyberg St and 65th Ave. The trail is closed at the Nyberg Woods (Best Buy) connection on the west and Browns Ferry Park on the east while this connection is being made. They will be paving some of Nyberg Lane in front of their development in the next few weeks; expect delays during paving.
Ride Connection	Ride Connection has opened the new Green Line of the Tualatin Shuttle providing small bus service from the Bridgeport Park-and-Ride through Downtown Tualatin (and the WES Station) and out Borland Rd to the social services at Rolling Hills Church on Borland near Stafford Rd.
