



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – July 19, 2023

<p>I-5/Hwy 217 Interchange</p>	<p>As part of the Hwy 217 project, ODOT’s contractor will be narrowing Hwy 217 northbound to a single lane from I-5 to Hwy 99W starting Friday evening July 21 through July 31st. The merge to a single lane will start on the ‘flyover’ ramp from I-5 north to Hwy 217 and continue north as a single lane through the Hwy 99W interchange. Expect significant traffic delays on both Hwy 217 and I-5 Northbound from Wilsonville through Tigard.</p> <p>These closures are necessary for the OR 217 Auxiliary Lanes Project to build a section of the new auxiliary lane on OR 217, which will reduce congestion by giving drivers more space and time to merge safely when it opens in 2025.</p>
<p>Hwy 99W (124th Ave to Pacific Dr / Pony Ridge Neighborhood)</p>	<p>Construction started this week on a new pedestrian walkway along the northwest side of Hwy 99W from 124th Ave to Pacific Drive and the Pony Ridge Neighborhood. This involves daytime right lane closures on Hwy 99W southbound while crews are working. This first phase of the project is removing trees, shrubs, and fences along the highway where the new walkway will be. The contractor plans to pour new curb ramps and a bus stop at the Pacific Dr / Hwy 99W intersection next week.</p>
<p>Herman Rd (Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave)</p>	<p>PGE and other utilities are relocating their poles and wires for a city-funded project to widen and reconstruct Herman Rd from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers, with delays likely during the day. Work is planned through October.</p> <p>A three-week road closure is planned in August for roadway reconstruction.</p>
<p>Boones Ferry Road Waterline between Ibach St and Norwood Rd</p>	<p>The contractor is constructing a new waterline along the west side of Boones Ferry Road from Ibach St to Norwood Rd. Some trees have been removed that were in direct conflict with the waterline. Work will continue in a couple of weeks along Norwood Road to 89th Avenue. Traffic is being controlled by flaggers; delays likely when they are working.</p> <p>Norwood Road will be closed at Boones Ferry Road next week (July 24th through 28th) for water line construction.</p>
<p>Boones Ferry Road Waterline from Norwood Rd to Greenhill Ln</p>	<p>A contractor will be constructing a new waterline along the east side of Boones Ferry Road from Norwood Road South to the new Plambeck Gardens housing development under construction between Horizon Church and Greenhill Lane. Work is planned to</p>

	<p>start next week. Norwood Road will be closed at Boones Ferry Road next week (July 24th through 28th) for water line construction.</p>
<p>Boones Ferry Rd from Avery St to Norwood Rd</p>	<p>The contractor has completed the major paving and striping work on Boones Ferry Road (from Avery to Ibach).</p> <p>Phase 2 of this roadway project – From Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Nasoma St, and the Ibach St and Iowa St intersections – will start construction in August. More information is at boonesferrycorridor.com.</p>
<p>Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5</p>	<p>The contractor has replaced the median (from Martinazzi to the Cabelas/Fred Meyer signal) this week and plans to pave the base layers of the new third lane this week (the lane will not be opened until final paving in September). This project is planned to last through October to improve Tualatin-Sherwood Road and Nyberg St from downtown Tualatin to the I-5 interchange by making traffic flow more efficient through improved lane usage. Most of the construction will be done at night to minimize disruption of traffic. However, as traffic is so busy in this area, some additional delay is likely.</p> <p>The contractor is planning to stripe improved bike lanes along Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Road to Martinazzi Avenue (near the Library) the night of August 14th.</p>
<p>Tualatin- Sherwood Rd (from Teton Ave to Sherwood)</p>	<p>Washington County’s contractor is building an additional travel lane and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. Traffic lanes have shifted through the work zone as the contractor is now working more on the north side of the road, including tree removal and construction of new curb and sidewalk.</p> <p>More information is on the Washington County website at Tualatin-Sherwood Road (Langer Farms Parkway to Teton Avenue) Washington County, OR (washingtoncountyor.gov) and Road closure / traffic information at Road Closures & Traffic Advisories WC-ROADS</p>
<p>Nyberg St between I-5 and 65th Avenue</p>	<p>A contractor for Washington County has poured new curb ramps to meet ADA standards along Nyberg Street east of Interstate 5. This is the first part of a project to pave Nyberg Street from Interstate 5 to 65th Avenue this summer.</p>

Nyberg Creek Area West of 65th Avenue	A contractor has dug a test pit to assess groundwater levels in preparation for a project this summer to replace a deteriorated sewer line along the south side of Nyberg Creek west of 65 th Ave.
Plambeck Gardens - Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road	The developer has begun construction of the Plambeck Gardens affordable housing complex on the East side of Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road and south of Horizon Church.
