



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – October 4th, 2023

<p><b>Boones Ferry Rd from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Sagert St and from Ibach St to Iowa Dr</b></p>	<p><b>The contractor is striping Boones Ferry at its intersections with Avery St and Ibach St tonight (10/4). Night paving is planned Monday (10/8-9) and Tuesday (10/9-10) nights from Tualatin-Sherwood to Warm Springs, with daytime paving the rest of the week from Warm Springs to Nasoma. Daytime signal work (with a signal shutdown) is planned at the Boones/Avery intersection Thursday 10/12. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers; expect delays.</b></p> <p>The contractor is building sidewalk, curb, and gutter, and preparing for paving the section of Boones Ferry from Tualatin-Sherwood Road to Sagert Street. Utility crews are also still working along Boones Ferry Road between Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Sagert St.</p> <p>More information is at <a href="http://www.boonesferrycorridor.com">www.boonesferrycorridor.com</a>.</p>
<p><b>Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5;</b></p> <p><b>Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Martinazzi Ave</b></p>	<p><b>The week of October 16<sup>th</sup> at night the contractor plans to pave Nyberg Street from the Cabela's/Fred Meyer signal to the I-5 Southbound Ramps, and pave the newly-widened center lane from Martinazzi to the Cabela's/Fred Meyer signal. The revised traffic lanes lines are planned to be painted on paving night, with permanent striping a couple weeks later.</b></p> <p>The contractor is installing irrigation and landscaping in the revised center median of Tualatin-Sherwood Road (between Martinazzi and Cabela's) and will be installing guardrail, working on signal modifications, and pouring concrete for the bike crossing near the I-5 Southbound ramps.</p>
<p><b>Herman Rd (Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave)</b></p>	<p><b>Herman Road (from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave) has been reopened and the roadway has been striped in its new lane configuration.</b> The contractor is continuing to work along the north side of the road building stormwater treatment planters and new sidewalks. Work is planned through October, delays possible.</p>
<p><b>67<sup>th</sup>, 68<sup>th</sup> Avenues and Sagert Street</b></p>	<p>The contractor is pouring new sidewalk, curb ramp, and crosswalk improvements along 67<sup>th</sup> and 68<sup>th</sup> Avenues north of Sagert St in the Las Casitas neighborhood this week. This project also includes new street lights around the 67<sup>th</sup>/68<sup>th</sup> Avenues loop. Next week the contractor starts building ramps for a new crosswalk with flashing lights across Sagert Street west of 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and in a few weeks a separated walkway/bikeway in place of a bike lane on the Sagert Street bridge over Interstate 5.</p>



## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – October 4th, 2023

<p><b>Nyberg St between I-5 and 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue</b></p>	<p>A contractor for Washington County has paved Nyberg Street from Interstate 5 to 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Striping is scheduled to be installed next week.</p>
<p><b>Hwy 99W (124<sup>th</sup> Ave to Pacific Dr / Pony Ridge Neighborhood)</b></p>	<p>The contractor is pouring a new pervious concrete pedestrian walkway and paving driveway connections along the northwest side of Hwy 99W from 124<sup>th</sup> Ave to Pacific Drive and the Pony Ridge Neighborhood. This involves daytime right lane closures on Hwy 99W southbound while crews are working.</p>
<p><b>Nyberg Creek Area West of 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue</b></p>	<p>A contractor is replacing a deteriorated sewer line along the south side of Nyberg Creek west of 65<sup>th</sup> Ave near the Rolling Hills Apartments, and has repaired some manholes and installed a new storm drainage pipe north of the apartments. Work continues this week installing the new sewer pipe through the medical clinic parking lot south of Nyberg Creek on the west side of 65<sup>th</sup> Ave, followed by connecting the new sewer to the existing system.</p>
<p><b>Plambeck Gardens - Boones Ferry Rd south of Norwood Rd</b></p>	<p>The developer is constructing the Plambeck Gardens affordable housing complex on the East side of Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road and south of Horizon Church.</p>
<p><b>Hazelbrook Road from Jurgens Ave to 115<sup>th</sup> Ave</b></p>	<p>The City's paving program has slurry sealed Hazelbrook Road. New striping has been installed in conjunction with the Tualatin Moving Forward program, with a double-yellow centerline, new bike lanes and added space for cyclists, and narrowed travel lanes to visually narrow the roadway to reduce vehicle speeds.</p>
<p><b>Tualatin- Sherwood Rd (from Teton Ave to Sherwood)</b></p>	<p>Washington County's contractor is building additional travel lanes and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. The contractor is now working more on the north side of the road, including tree removal and construction of new curb and sidewalk.
