



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – February 16, 2023

<p>Boones Ferry Rd from Blake/Alsea to Ibach St</p>	<p>The contractor is replacing the pathway along the east side of Boones Ferry Rd from Ibach St to Blake St and working along the newly-reopened pathway on the west side of Boones Ferry between Sagert and Ibach; while the path has reopened, please use caution in this active construction zone. More information is at boonesferrycorridor.com. While the contractor is working hard to move traffic, Expect delays between Arikara and Ibach during the day.</p>
<p>Tualatin- Sherwood Rd and Teton Ave</p>	<p>Washington County's contractor is excavating to widen and add pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. Excavation and clearing along the south side of Tualatin-Sherwood Road is moving east from 115th Ave towards Teton Ave. Contractors for utility companies (PGE, NW Natural, Comcast, etc.) are working to make way for the Road construction. Traffic delays are likely. <p>Norwood Rd</p>	<p>A private developer is widening Norwood Rd in conjunction with the large residential Autumn Sunrise Subdivision south of Norwood Rd west of Interstate 5. Current work includes installing base for the widened road area and laying pipes for water, sewer, and storm drainage. Delays are likely.</p>
<p>Martinazzi Ave at Mohawk St</p>	<p>The contractor has poured new curb ramps on Martinazzi Ave at Mohawk St and near Fred Meyer, and on Boones Ferry Rd at 84th Ave, and have started installing flashing lights at the Martinazzi/Mohawk and Boones Ferry/84th crosswalks.</p>
<p>Blake St and Makah Ct</p>	<p>The contractor has completed the pipe work and repaved the roadways over the upsized sewer main under Blake St and Makah Ct east of Martinazzi Ave. They are now working on final repairs, adjustments, and cleanup.</p>
<p>Hazelbrook Area</p>	<p>The contractor has poured new curb ramps on Tualatin Rd and Jurgens Ave near to meet ADA standards and install flashing lights at the Tualatin Rd crosswalks. Tualatin Rd traffic will be controlled by flaggers; expect delays between 9am and 3pm. This project will also stripe new bike lanes along the existing travel lanes along Jurgens Ave and Hazelbrook Rd this Spring/Summer.</p>



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – February 16, 2023

<p>Herman Rd</p>	<p>The private developer building new industrial buildings along Herman Rd (between Tualatin Rd and Teton Ave) will be working in Herman Rd to install new water connections for the new buildings. Two-way traffic will be in a single lane controlled by flaggers; Expect delays on Herman between Teton and Tualatin Rd for the next couple of weeks.</p> <p>The City has opened construction bids to widen and reconstruct Herman Rd from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave. Council will consider awarding the contract February 27th, with construction planned from March through October.</p>
<p>65th Ave near Meridian Hospital</p>	<p>Construction started this week to add a crosswalk with flashing lights across 65th Ave near Meridian Park Hospital.</p>
<p>Nyberg St and 65th Ave</p>	<p>A private developer is building the Tualatin River Trail connection behind the new apartment complex on the old RV Park property along Nyberg Lane near its intersection with Nyberg St and 65th Ave. The trail is closed at the Nyberg Woods (Best Buy) connection on the west and Browns Ferry Park on the east while this connection is being made. They will be paving some of Nyberg Lane in front of their development in the next few weeks; expect delays during paving.</p>
<p>Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5</p>	<p>The City is seeing construction bids for a project to improve Tualatin-Sherwood Road and Nyberg St from downtown Tualatin to the I-5 interchange to make traffic flow more efficient through improved lane usage. Bids open March 14th, with construction anticipated from April through October.</p>
