



## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – September 14th, 2023

<p><b>Herman Rd (Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave)</b></p>	<p><b>Herman Road (from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave) is closed from August 17<sup>th</sup> through September 18th for roadway reconstruction. The ‘hard’ closure is between Tualatin Road and the industrial access private rail crossing (shown on some maps as Powder Ct). Adjacent properties are typically accessed from the West.</b></p> <p>During this closure, the contractor has constructed a new storm drainage system under the roadway and is building/rebuilding the roadway base and pavement structure. They will then construct new curbs along the road and new sidewalk and stormwater planters along the North side of the road. The detour route is Tualatin Road and Teton Ave. Expect additional traffic on the detour route, and some delays. Work is planned through October.</p>
<p><b>Boones Ferry Rd from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Sagert St and from Ibach St to Iowa Dr</b></p>	<p>The contractor is constructing new sidewalks and ADA ramps and removing and replacing the center median (from Mohawk to Warm Springs) this week. Expect lane shifts and potential delays along Boones Ferry from Tualatin-Sherwood Road to Sagert Street through mid-October.</p> <p>In a couple of weeks, the contractor will be repaving Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Road to north of Sagert Street. Expect delays, flaggers, and lane closures from Sagert to Warm Springs for paving during the day. The section of Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood to Warm Springs will be paved at night during a road closure from 9pm to 5am.</p> <p>Utility crews are still working along Boones Ferry Road between Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Sagert St in preparation for roadway construction in a couple of weeks. <p><b>Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5;</b></p> <p><b>Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Martinazzi Ave</b></p>	<p><b>On the nights of September 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> the contractor plans to pave Nyberg Street from the Cabela’s/Fred Meyer signal to the I-5 Southbound Ramps, and pave the newly-widened center lane from Martinazzi to the Cabela’s/Fred Meyer signal. The revised traffic lanes lines are planned to be painted on paving night, with permanent striping a couple weeks later.</b></p> <p>The contractor is continuing to pour improved ADA curb ramps through the project area. The contractor has striped improved bike lanes along Boones Ferry Road from Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Martinazzi Ave (by the Library), and a new section of bike lane on Tualatin Road north of Boones Ferry Road.</p>



## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – September 14th, 2023

<p><b>Nyberg St between I-5 and 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue</b></p>	<p>A contractor for Washington County has paved Nyberg Street from Interstate 5 to 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Striping will be installed in a couple of weeks.</p>
<p><b>Boones Ferry / Norwood Waterline between Ibach St and B-Level Reservoirs</b></p>	<p>The contractor has completed, tested, and connected the new section of 18" water main along Boones Ferry Road from Ibach St to Norwood Rd and along Norwood Road from Boones Ferry Rd to the reservoir connection at 89<sup>th</sup> Ave. They are currently restoring landscaping etc. and cleaning up. Some delays are possible.</p>
<p><b>Boones Ferry Road Waterline from Norwood Rd to Greenhill Ln</b></p>	<p>A contractor has constructed a new waterline along the east side of Boones Ferry Road from Norwood Rd South to the new Plambeck Gardens housing development under construction between Horizon Church and Greenhill Lane. The contractor has paved over the new water pipes on Boones Ferry Road.</p>
<p><b>Hwy 99W (124<sup>th</sup> Ave to Pacific Dr / Pony Ridge Neighborhood)</b></p>	<p>A contractor is building a new pedestrian walkway along the northwest side of Hwy 99W from 124<sup>th</sup> Ave to Pacific Drive and the Pony Ridge Neighborhood. This involves daytime right lane closures on Hwy 99W southbound while crews are working. Crews will be working next week excavating and preparing the base for the new pathway.</p>
<p><b>Nyberg Creek Area West of 65<sup>th</sup> Avenue</b></p>	<p>A contractor is replacing a deteriorated sewer line along the south side of Nyberg Creek west of 65<sup>th</sup> Ave near the Rolling Hills Apartments, and has repaired some manholes and installed a new storm drainage pipe north of the apartments. Work continues this week (and weekend) installing the new sewer pipe through the medical clinic parking lot south of Nyberg Creek on the west side of 65<sup>th</sup> Ave.</p>
<p><b>Plambeck Gardens - Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road</b></p>	<p>The developer is constructing the Plambeck Gardens affordable housing complex on the East side of Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road and south of Horizon Church.</p>
<p><b>67<sup>th</sup>, 68<sup>th</sup> Avenues and Sagert Street</b></p>	<p>Work starts Monday September 25th building new street lights and sidewalk, curb ramp, and crosswalk improvements along 67<sup>th</sup> and 68<sup>th</sup> Avenues north of Sagert St in the Las Casitas neighborhood, a new crosswalk with flashing lights across Sagert Street west of 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and a separated walkway/bikeway in place of a bike lane on the Sagert Street bridge over Interstate 5. With this, all of the Tualatin Moving Forward projects are now either under construction or complete.</p>



## WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – September 14th, 2023

<b>Avery Street between Boones Ferry Rd and Martinazzi Ave</b>	The City's paving program has repaved Avery Street from Boones Ferry Road to Martinazzi Avenue. New striping was installed this week – with most of the centerline omitted and white shoulder lines installed denoting parking lanes to make this part of Avery Street look more like a neighborhood street and visually narrow the traveled way to reduce vehicle speeds.
<b>Tualatin- Sherwood Rd (from Teton Ave to Sherwood)</b>	<p>Washington County's contractor is building an additional travel lane and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood.
