



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – June 16, 2023

<p>Boones Ferry Rd from Avery St to Norwood Rd</p>	<p><u>Boones Ferry Road (from Avery to Ibach) will be paved the weeks of June 19th through 28th. Flaggers will have both directions of traffic alternating through a single lane through the paving work zone from 7am to about 7pm while paving is in progress. Expect significant traffic delays during paving, and single-day closures of side streets intersecting Boones Ferry in this area.</u></p> <p>The contractor has turned on the new lights along the pathway on the west side of Boones Ferry between Avery and Siletz, and has activated the flashing lights at the crosswalk near Apache St. Utility companies (PGE and Ziplly) are relocating poles and wires to make way for Phase 2 of this project and a project to build a new water line from Ibach St to south of Norwood Road this summer. Delays possible when they are working. More information is at boonesferrycorridor.com.</p> <p>Phase 2 of this project – From Tualatin-Sherwood Rd to Nasoma St, and the Avery St and Iowa St intersections - is coming later this Summer.</p>
<p>Tualatin- Sherwood Rd and Teton Ave</p>	<p>Washington County's contractor is building an additional travel lane and pathways along Tualatin-Sherwood Rd from Teton Ave west into Sherwood. Traffic lanes have shifted through the work zone as the contractor is now working more on the north side of the road. <p>Tualatin-Sherwood Rd and Nyberg St from Martinazzi to I-5</p>	<p>Construction is planned to start next week (and last through October) to improve Tualatin-Sherwood Road and Nyberg St from downtown Tualatin to the I-5 interchange to make traffic flow more efficient through improved lane usage. Most of the construction will be done at night to minimize disruption of traffic. However, as traffic is so busy in this area, some additional delay is likely.</p>
<p>Herman Rd</p>	<p>Utility work continues this week along Herman Rd preparing for a city-funded project to widen and reconstruct Herman Rd from Tualatin Rd to Teton Ave. Major road construction (including a three-week Herman Road closure) is planned in July and August, with the project lasting until October.</p>



WEEKLY PROJECT UPDATE – June 16, 2023

<p>Nyberg Lane East of 65th Ave</p>	<p>A private developer has opened the Tualatin River Trail connection behind the new apartment complex on the old RV Park property along Nyberg Lane near its intersection with Nyberg St and 65th Ave.</p>
<p>Nyberg St between I-5 and 65th Avenue</p>	<p>A contractor for Washington County is retrofitting curb ramps to meet ADA standards along Nyberg Street east of Interstate 5. This is the first part of a project to pave Nyberg Street from Interstate 5 to 65th Avenue this summer.</p>
<p>65th Ave near Meridian Hospital</p>	<p>The contractor has poured new sidewalk, ramps, and a center island to add a crosswalk with flashing lights across 65th Ave near Meridian Park Hospital. They have striped the crosswalk and activated the flashing lights.</p>
<p>Hazelbrook Area</p>	<p>The contractor has activated the new flashing lights at the Tualatin Rd crosswalks. This project has also striped new bike lanes along the existing travel lanes along Jurgens Ave and a portion of Tualatin Rd, and new crosswalks across Tualatin Rd.</p>
<p>Norwood Rd</p>	<p>A private developer has widened Norwood Rd in conjunction with the large residential Autumn Sunrise Subdivision south of Norwood Rd west of Interstate 5. The developer has paved Norwood Road and the streets inside the subdivision, and is pouring ADA curb ramps at the 89th and Vermillion intersections this week.</p>
<p>Hwy 99W (124th Ave to Pacific Dr / Pony Ridge Neighborhood)</p>	<p>Construction begins soon of a new pedestrian walkway along the northwest side of Hwy 99W from 124th Ave to Pacific Drive and the Pony Ridge Neighborhood.</p>
<p>Plambeck Gardens - Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road</p>	<p>The developer has begun construction of the Plambeck Gardens affordable housing complex on the East side of Boones Ferry Road south of Norwood Road and south of Horizon Church.</p>
