I love noodles. Give me oodles. Make a mound up to the sun. Noodles are my favorite foodles. I eat noodles by the ton.






FINGERPLAYS & SONGS

I'm a little teapot Short and stout Here is my handle Here is my spout When I get all steamed up Hear me shout "Tip me over, and Pour me out!"




One grew, two grew, And so did all the rest They grew & they grew and they did not stop Until one day that pod went POP!






