

Wax Resist Watercolor

Items Needed:

Glossy paper
Scissors
Wax Paper
Iron
Watercolor paints
Paint Brush
Water

Instructions:

- Cut a piece of wax paper roughly the size of your paper
- Crumple or fold your waxed paper then flatten
- Place waxed paper between two pieces of paper
- Turn iron onto high (but do not use steam setting) and iron the paper for 2 minutes, making sure to move the iron constantly to avoid burning paper
- Turn off iron and remove waxed paper and turn the top piece of paper over
- Use watercolor paint to cover the page
- Allow to dry

Optional: before drying, sprinkle salt on painting to get speckled appearance
