## Washer Necklaces

Supplies:

- $\quad$ Washers (2)
- 12 mm wooden beads (2)
- 10 mm wooden beads (3)
- 8 mm glass beads (4)
- $\quad$ Clear pony beads (6)
- Black pony beads (4)
- $\quad$ Waxed cord (4 ft)
- Baker's twine (4 ft)
- $\quad$ Nail polish (1 bottle)

Instructions:

1. Paint your washers using the nail polish. You'll want a nice thick coat. Let dry.
2. Flip them over and paint the other sides (nice and thick). Let dry.
3. Repeat steps $1 \& 2$ until you have a nice, smooth layer of paint on both sides.
4. Create a long loop with your cord of choice. Put the rounded end of the loop through the washer hole. Pull the two other ends through the loop and draw the ends completely through. Looking at the picture will help if you aren't sure what this means.
5. Lace your beads however you think would be the coolest. You can lace each side of the necklace cord, or put beads through both pieces of cord to create a focal bead. Look at the pictures for some ideas.
6. Tie the two ends together to complete your necklace. Go forth and be fashionable.
