Tornado in a Jar

What you need:
A jar with a tight fitting lid
Water
Dish soap
Small beads or legos or sparkles (optional)
Glitter (optional)
Food coloring (optional)

How you do it:

- 1. Fill the jar with water, leaving about 1" space at the top.
- 2. Add a generous squirt of dish soap (approx. 1 teaspoon) and one or two drops of food colouring.
- 3. Screw the lid back on securely and swirl it around to mix it.
- 4. Swirl the jar in a circular motion as fast as you can until tornadoes form.
- 5. If you're having trouble with too many bubbles, try adding 1 teaspoon of vinegar and using a spoon to scoop out the bubbles on the top.
