“Trees are _____”


Open to all fifth grade Tualatin residents

*All Tualatin fifth grade students are invited to participate in the 8th annual **Arbor Day Poster Contest** by creating a poster with the theme “Trees are _____”*

The contest is sponsored by the City of Tualatin.

Poster Contest Rules

1. All entries must be original artwork created by a student who is currently in the fifth grade and a resident of Tualatin. A student may enter the contest only once.
2. **Name, school, teacher, and contact information must be on back of poster.**
3. a) Entries may be done in marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, and/or tempera paint.
b) Collages are not acceptable (Do not glue anything on your poster)
c) Computer or photo generated art and/or printing is not acceptable.
d) Entries should not display the names of commercial products, companies, or organizations.
4. Entries may be done on the paper provided or on other paper. The paper used must be no smaller than 8 ½”X11” and no larger than 11”X17”.
5. Entries must be done on paper that will allow for duplication, display, and framing.
6. The poster must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme is **“Trees are _____”**. The artist must fill in the blank and create a poster that reflects their theme. The theme must be on the poster. All words must be spelled correctly.
7. Entries should not be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, or folded.
8. **Deadline for submitting your poster is March 5, 2015.** Posters should be collected by your teacher and left in the front office for pick up. Posters may also be dropped off at the Community Services Building located at 8515 SW Tualatin Road by March 5, 2015.



One 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner from each school, and one city-wide 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winner will be selected by the City of Tualatin.


All 1st, 2nd and 3rd place school winners will:

- Be invited to the March 23, 2015 City Council Meeting to be recognized.
- Have their poster displayed at the Tualatin Public Library April 6-10
- Receive a “Tualatin, Oregon 25th Tree City” bracelet
- Receive an Arbor Day Foundation water bottle.
- Have their poster framed.


