



## 12<sup>th</sup> Annual West Coast Giant Pumpkin Regatta Medallion Hunt Contest Rules

In celebration of the **12<sup>th</sup> Annual West Coast Giant Pumpkin Regatta** the City of Tualatin is once again bringing you the Regatta Medallion Hunt! A link to a series clue will be revealed in the Tualatin Times newspaper and on the Regatta Medallion Hunt [webpage](#) on 9/17, 9/24, 10/1, and 10/8. These clues are designed to lead treasure hunters toward a hidden medallion. These clues, while not difficult, may require you to visit the Tualatin Public Library or the Tualatin Historical Society for help.

The search will be for a 4-inch diameter bronze medallion engraved with the Regatta mascot (pictured above). On the back of the medallion is information on how to redeem the medallion for a bounty of rewards!

### What is the prize?

The person who finds and returns the medallion will win a bronze Regatta medallion to keep, a one of a kind glass blown pumpkin from Live Laugh Love Glass, a Regatta t-shirt, Regatta poster, reusable City of Tualatin tote bag, and a collectible Regatta coin. The lucky treasure hunter will be awarded their prize at the **12<sup>th</sup> Annual West Coast Giant Pumpkin Regatta** on October 17<sup>th</sup> at the Tualatin Lake of the Commons. The prize will be awarded to the first person to find the medallion and follow the redemption information on the back of the medallion. There is only one prize, the grand prize. The City of Tualatin makes no warranty on the prize and restrictions may or may not be applied by Hayden's Lakefront Grill. The medallion must be redeemed within 24 hours of discovery.

### What do I need to find the medallion?

Not much other than curiosity, sturdy shoes, and a little legwork. The medallion is hidden on public property and is on the ground. No digging, climbing, or tools are necessary to retrieve it. The medallion will be within 200 feet of the location of the last clue. Please take care not to damage plants, grass, or other flora. All applicable laws and rules must be observed and failing to do so may result in disqualification.

### Who can participate?

The medallion hunt is open to anyone other than City of Tualatin employees and elected officials, and the Tualatin Historical Society staff or members of the Board of Directors. Participation is voluntary and the City of Tualatin and its partners bear no legal or financial responsibility for your participation.

### When does the contest start and end?

A clue will be revealed in the Tualatin Times newspaper on the Regatta [webpage](#) on 9/17, 9/24, 10/1, and 10/8. The hidden medallion will be in place on or before the publication date of the last clue. The contest will end when the medallion has been redeemed. Notice will appear on the Regatta [webpage](#) when the medallion has been redeemed. If the medallion has not been found by midnight on October 16, 2015 the contest will officially end and the prize will not be awarded.

### Conflict Resolution

In case of discrepancy about rules, the contest, or anything relating to the Medallion Hunt, the City of Tualatin's Park and Recreation Manager shall make the ultimate and binding ruling.
