

## RECREATIONAL CANNABIS ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

## **RECITALS:**

- 1. Prior to issuance of a cannabis license, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission asks the City to indicate on a Land Use Compatibility Statement (LUCS), whether the proposed recreational cannabis use is allowed or prohibited by the City's land use code.
- 2. The City of Tualatin, TDC Chapter 80, prohibits a new recreational cannabis uses from locating within 1,000 feet of an existing cannabis use (among other restrictions). The distance is measured from the closest property lines (not tax lots).
- 3. The City will indicate on a LUCS that a proposed recreational cannabis use is allowed if, at the time of the City's signature on the LUCS, the proposed recreational cannabis use is 1,000 feet from any existing recreational cannabis use, measured from the closest property lines (not tax lots).

Even if City staff have completed and signed a LUCS indicating that my proposed recreational cannabis
use was allowed at the time the LUCS was executed, it is possible that prior to the time I receive my
OLCC license, OLCC may approve a license for another recreational cannabis use located within 1,000
feet of my proposed location. If that happens, the LUCS previously approved by the City for my
proposed location will become null and void.
