

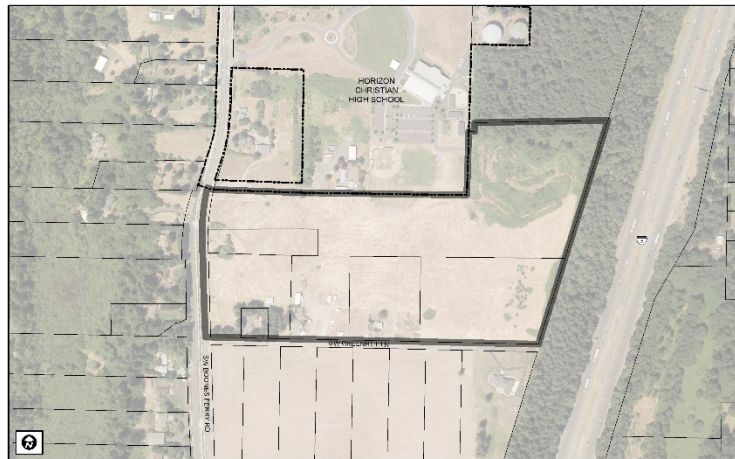
NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Date of Decision: March 23, 2020

The City of Tualatin adopted Ordinance No. 1430-20 approving the annexation of territory located at 23620, 23740 SW Boones Ferry Road and 9185, 9335, 9415 SW Greenhill Lane (Tax Map: 2S135D Lots: 400, 401, 500, 501, 600, 800, and 900) and portions of SW Boones Ferry Road into the City of Tualatin; withdrawing the territory from the Washington County Enhanced Sheriff Patrol District; and annexing the territory into the boundary of Clean Water Services (File No. ANN19-0002).

Effective Date of Ordinance: The effective date of the ordinance is on the 30th day after its adoption, pursuant to the Tualatin City Charter.

Effective Date of Annexation: The annexation is effective following the filing of the annexation with the Secretary of State, as provided in ORS 222.180.
