Notice of decision shall be provided to the property owner, applicant and any person who submitted written comments in accordance with 32.220(3). The decisions shall each become final 14 calendar days after the date the notice of the decision is given unless written request for review of the Architectural Features or Utility Facilities decision is submitted on a form provided by the City for that purpose.

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
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


- Inspection of print copies of the application materials and applicable criteria are available at no cost, and copies are available at a reasonable cost at the Planning Division Office.

  to receive a Notice of Decision and have standing to submit an Appeal, in accordance with TDC
  32.220. Issues which may provide the basis for an appeal to the Architectural Review Board, City
  Council and Land Use Board of Appeals shall be raised in writing prior to the expiration of the
  comment period. Issues shall be raised with sufficient detail and clarity to enable the decision
  maker to respond to the issue and state how a person may be adversely affected by the proposal.
- Notice of the Architectural Review Decision will only be provided to those who submit written comments regarding that application.
