

## NOTICE OF ADOPTION

On November 23, 2020, the City of Tualatin adopted Ordinance No. 1445-20 amending Tualatin Development Code Chapter 80 relating to Cannabis Regulations and making minor amendments to other Tualatin Development Code Chapters (File No. PTA 20-0006).

### Summary of proposal:

Changes to Tualatin Development Code Chapter 80 include:

- Replace reference to marijuana with cannabis;
- Allowing retail businesses to locate in industrial and commercial zones;
- Reducing the required minimum distance between cannabis business to schools, libraries, parks, and residential areas from 3,000 to 1,000 feet;
- Reducing the required minimum distance between cannabis businesses from 2,000 to 1,000 feet; and
- Removing size limitation on cannabis facilities.

Review of land use decisions is commenced by filing a Notice of Intent to Appeal with the Land Use Board of Appeals as provided in ORS 197.830 to 197.845. The notice of intent to appeal a land use decision must be filed within 21 days of the date the decision becomes final (December 14, 2020), as provided in ORS 197.830(9) and OAR 661-010-0010(3).
