**UPDATE: Police Still Asking for Your Help Identifying
Suspect in Forgery Case**

Tualatin Police are still asking for the public's help to identify the female suspect linked to multiple forgery cases spanning the I5 corridor. Our original press release went out on May 1, 2017 and contained two photographs of the suspect. Since that time police have acquired several additional photos of the suspect.
