

- Reduce emissions responsible for climate change.



#### Bottles & jars only, empty & dry



Include household batteries in unincorporated Washington County, Banks, Durham, Hillsboro, King City, North Plains, Tigard and Sherwood.



- 1. Tape ends of all batteries except alkaline.
- 2. Collect in zip-sealed plastic bag and place in glass bin.
